**NOTIFICATION**

TO CMBAT SPREAD OF COVID-19

In view of the Notification made by the Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Higher Education, Bikash Bhavan, Salt Lake City, Kolkata-700091 Vide No. 08.Pr.Secy.HED/2020 dated 16/04/2020 and subsequent my earlier Communication Vide No VC/F.110/03/2020/DP-2226 dated 19<sup>th</sup> March, 2020 the following are modified as follows:

1. The University will remain closed till 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2020 in public interest.
2. All academic activities, including internal examinations, as well as mass gatherings, seminars, workshops, conferences, cultural activities, field trips and foreign travel to be undertaken by the faculty member, research scholars and students with University support will remain suspended till 10<sup>th</sup> June 2020.
3. However, the Office of the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar, Finance Officer, Controller of Examinations and Directorate of Open and Distance Learning (DODL) will function on need basis as and when required after strictly maintaining the protocol of COVID-19.
4. Such essential services as the supply of electricity and water, security, sweeping and cleaning and IT will be maintained.
5. Students are advised not to enter the campus and their department. But they are advised to keep in touch with their teachers through emails/e-learning to maintain their academic programmes.
6. Hostels will remain closed till 10<sup>th</sup> of June, 2020. But adequate arrangements as per medical protocol will be made for foreign students who are not able to leave the campus due to distance or otherwise. No visitor should be allowed during the period to visit the hostel, without prior approval of the Head of the Institute.
7. World Health Organization and State Government Guidelines concerning CARONA pandemic need to be strictly followed in the campus.
8. The members of the faculty and research scholars are strongly advised not to come to their respective Department. But for any emergency access to research laboratories, the concern Head of the Department are required to take prior permission from the authority through email ([vckufedback@gmail.com](mailto:vckufedback@gmail.com)).
